



DIGITAL SECURITY AGREEMENT

(HIGH SCHOOL PARENTS & STUDENTS ONLY)

One of the goals of SCA is to prepare students to be responsible digital citizens with the ability to use emerging technology. SCA's mobile device manager tracks and monitors every site that a student attempts to access. If anyone attempts to access a blocked site, the IT Department is alerted.

We are demonstrating proactivity in the area of safety and security in the following ways:

- We are providing on-campus filtering and G-rating restrictions.
- We are providing families with the option to continue restrictions/filtering off-campus.
- The school is implementing digital safety and security training throughout the curriculum. SCA has also developed a required semester-long digital citizenship course to address security and safety issues from a biblical perspective.
- Should any inappropriate use come to our attention, the school will work closely with parents on effective discipline, including restricting the use of the iPad, if that becomes necessary.

In turn, we ask your due diligence in partnering with us as follows:

- Maintain open communication with your child on iPad usage.
- Regularly check/monitor your child's digital history, Facebook, etc. Become an expert!
- Attend SCA-offered meetings in the fall where we will provide training on a variety of topics to support you as the parent expert.
- Require your child to give you all passwords to all accounts.

As you may know, Summit Christian has invested in the use of Lightspeed as our mobile device manager. This filtering system provides multiple levels of blocking that may be placed on any given device. In the spirit of partnership, we would like you to choose and update the filter to be used on your child's iPad.

There are two levels of off-campus restrictions/filtering from which you may choose. After determining what best suits your student's needs, follow the given directions. After typing the link and hitting "enter," the device will update with your selection. A report will automatically generate at SCA showing that your student's iPad has filtering in place. A student's name must be reflected on the report to be able to use the SCA network. Under Settings, General, About, please change iPad to your student's name.

Level 1 Provides no filtering or restrictions while off campus.

Description: No off-site filtering or restrictions of any kind while off campus. The iPad settings are controlled by a mobile device management system (Lightspeed) only while student is physically at Summit Christian Academy. Off campus, the device returns to iPad factory default settings.

To select this option:

Follow the prompt to complete the setup

Level 2 Provides G-rating filtering and restrictions.

This is the level of filtering SCA uses on campus.

Description: This level of filtering provides “G-rating” restrictions and Internet filtering at all times while surfing the Internet and is the only level that provides off-campus Internet filtering.

Lightspeed identifies and blocks the following:

- Adult products, services, situations, humor, adult art, body art, adult games, adult language, adult lifestyles.
- Alcohol production, promotion and sale of alcoholic beverages, drugs, sites promoting illicit and illegal drug use.
- Gambling, casinos, betting, lottery and play-for-cash/sweepstakes.
- Offensive websites considered offensive to both adults and children, pornography-related sites, websites containing potentially illegal or pornographic material.
- Suspicious or recently discovered sites with suspicious words or phrases; sites that promote violence and anarchy.
- Forums with unmoderated personal expression, forums, blogs, web blogs, dating websites (like friendfinder, eharmony, and match.com), personals, personal web pages, and personal ads.
- Forums with instant messaging, email sites, newsgroups, usenet, and subscription newsletters.
- Forums with social networking and related websites such as myspace, facebook, and orkut.

To select this option:

Make an appointment with Mr. Dan Cockrell (*it will take approximately 30 minutes*).

SCA is using a mobile device manager that restricts the use of mobile device cameras or recording apps between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:15 p.m. whether the device is at school or not. Students will need to receive permission from a teacher or administrator in circumstances where camera or recording use is needed during these hours.

By signing this document (one for each student), you are stating that you have chosen a restriction level and have gone to the suggested site using your Safari browser. If you have any questions concerning filtering, please email dcockrell@sca-kc.org. He may also be reached at 525-1480 x302.
